Competition

The SOAP violin Concerto Competition provides young talented musicians an opportunity to perform a solo concerto with orchestra as well as to receive promotional exposure through SOAP.

Jury

The jury consists of a Chairman and six international judges

Eligibility

This international competition is open to interested violinists who are accepted to SOAP.

Competition Rules & Repertoire

1. The competition is divided into two rounds. Both rounds will be open to the public. A maximum of 3 violinists will be admitted to the finals.

Semi finals: excerpts from the Tchaikovsky Violin Concerto (unaccompanied)

Finals: complete Tchaikovsky Violin Concerto with piano accompaniment

2. The concerto must be played from memory.

3. The order of playing in the competition will be decided by ballot at 12 o'clock noon on June 22, 2010 at the Academy of Music, Powell River.

4. The organizers of the competition will have unlimited rights to broadcast the competition performances on radio and television, to make audio and video tapes, films and records and to show and distribute performance excerpts on the Internet and other data networks without paying any remuneration to the competitors or their accompanists.

5. The decisions of the jury are final

Dates

1st round: 7pm Tuesday June 22, 2010

2nd round: 7 pm Wednesday June 23, 2010

Awards

1st prize winner will perform the *Tchaikovsky Violin Concerto in D Major* with the Symphony Orchestra of the Pacific July 2, 2010 and be awarded the position of concertmaster, with full scholarship, for SOAP 2011.

2nd prize winner will be featured with a solo performance (own choice) during the second faculty chamber music concert July 1, 2010 and awarded the position of leader of second violins, with full scholarship, for SOAP 2011.
